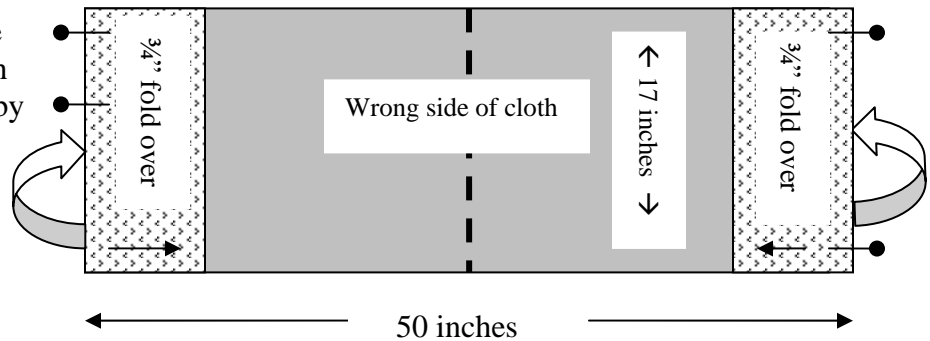


HOW TO MAKE A SCRIBAL PORTFOLIO CASE

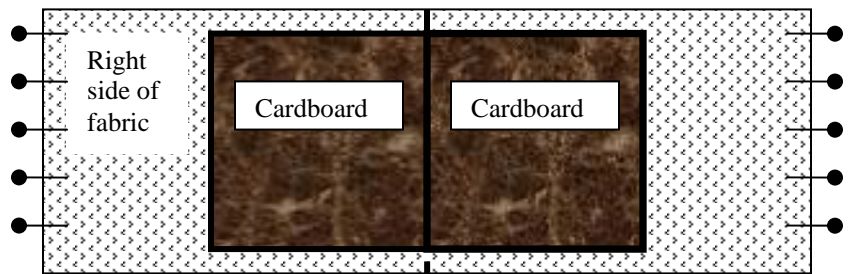

There are many ways to make a scribal portfolio case. This is one way to make it.

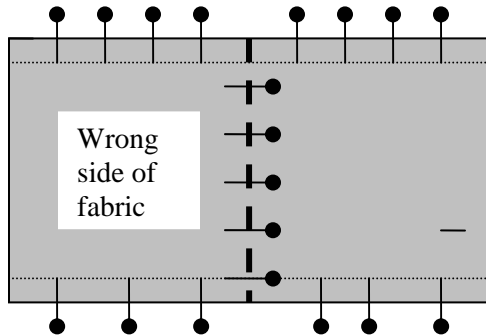
1) Layout fabric, wrong side up, find center and mark with pins. Fold over outer edges by $\frac{3}{4}$ " and pin in place.



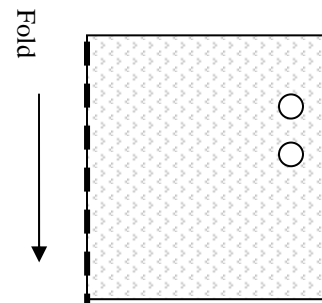
2) Turned pinned piece over so that the right side of the fabric faces you. Put the cardboard section against each other in the center of the cloth. Fold pinned edges to the center.



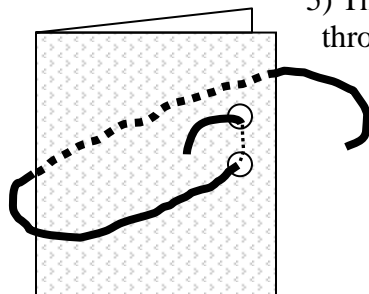
Fold pinned edge towards the center → ←Fold pinned edge towards the center



3) Pin open edges of the case $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowances on dotted lines. Clip corners and turn inside right. Slide cardboard sections into cloth sleeves. Close like a book.



4) With a leather hole punch, cut 2 holes in 1 side of the case, going through all layers of cloth and cardboard. Holes should be $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge and 1" apart as shown in the diagram. →



5) Thread ribbon or cording through the holes as shown and tie on the side.
